Assembly

Persons attending are requested to assemble in Calga Reserve (at the eastern end of Trafalgar Street), Bronte, by 11.15 a.m. When all are assembled, we will move together to the Richardson Family Vault where the ceremony will be held commencing at 11.30 a.m.

Post Ceremony

The ceremony will conclude by 11.50 a.m. Persons attending may then wish to view some of the other famous graves in the cemetery before proceeding on foot around the headland (enjoying the magnificent scenery en route) about 500 metres to Bronte village (opposite the Bronte Beach bus terminus at the southern end of Bronte Park), where a light lunch may be purchased in local licensed and unlicensed cafés at participants' own expense.

Transport

The 378 Bronte via Bondi Junction Bus (Sydney Buses) departs Central Station (Eddy Avenue Stand A) at 10.28 a.m. and Bondi Junction Interchange Stand D at 10.56 a.m. Alight at the corner of Macpherson Street North and Tipper Avenue, Bronte, at 11.06 a.m. [as the bus proceeds east along Macpherson Street towards Bronte Beach, this is the first stop beyond the Bronte RSL Club] and then walk via Tipper Avenue and Trafalgar Street to the assembly point (about 150 metres).

The 378 bus service departs at 10-minute intervals during the day from Central to Bronte Beach (via Bondi Junction) and return. Please note that this is a "Pre-pay" service. You must purchase a ticket at a pre-pay outlet before boarding.

There is limited car parking in local streets near the assembly point.

There is no cost for attendance and reservations are not necessary.
